Award Categories

Community Service

The Community Service Award will recognize the social responsibility of an APSCU institution for its leadership and dedication to programs that have benefited the community. Programs that will be considered include, but are not limited to, aid to the disadvantaged, scholarship programs, community-related public relations, and special activities.

Most Innovative Best Practice/New Program Award

The Most Innovative Best Practices/New Program Award recognizes institutions and/or organizations that have contributed to the private postsecondary career school sector through successful implementation of innovative methods that benefited an institution, student, the career school sector, or the community at-large during the 2011 calendar year. Criteria that will be considered include, but are not limited to, those related to curriculum, instruction, retention, employment, or recruitment. Nominees will be evaluated on general indicators of success as they relate to individual best practices or new programs as well as the level of innovativeness. They may take the form of new groundbreaking ideas that pave the way for others to follow, or may include classic approaches that have been either renovated to produce extraordinary outcomes that had not been achieved previously or applied in a new context with successful outcomes. The committee will be looking for the best practices or new programs to: increase student recognition, enhance image, inspire faculty, promote goodwill, stimulate achievement, build employee morale, assist with placement, improve retention, present new opportunities, provide learner-centered curriculum, or support community involvement.

Limitation Notice: An institution can only win this award once every two consecutive years.

Please limit your nomination to no more than 10 pages.
